

PERMISSION TO POST PERSONAL INFORMATION ON INTERNET

Government Code §6254.21.

- a) No state or local agency shall post the home address or telephone number of any elected or appointed official on the Internet without first obtaining the written permission of that individual.
- b) For purposes of this section "elected or appointed official" includes, *but is not limited to*, all of the following: (1) State constitutional officers (2) Members of the Legislature (3) Judges and court commissioners (4) District attorneys (5) Public defenders (6) Members of a city council (7) Members of a board of supervisors (8) Appointees of the Governor (9) Appointees of the Legislature (10) Mayors (11) City attorneys (12) Police chiefs and sheriffs.


